ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On April 13, 1999, MCImetro Access Transmission Services (MCImetro), an MCI WorldCom company, filed an application to intervene and become a party in this case. MCImetro's application indicates that it is a competitive telecommunications carrier authorized to provide intrastate interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri as well as an authorized provider of interstate interexchange telecommunications services subject to the jurisdiction of the Federal Communications Commission. MCImetro seeks to intervene in this proceeding because the Commission's decision may affect its interests as a provider of telecommunications services. MCImetro asserts that it has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding which is different from that of the general public and that granting the intervention would serve the public interest because of MCImetro's interest in enhancing competition, and because of its expertise in the telecommunications industry.


The Commission has reviewed the application to intervene filed by MCImetro and finds that it is in compliance with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) and that MCImetro has an interest in this matter that is different from that of the general public. The Commission concludes that the application for intervention filed by MCImetro should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That MCImetro Access Transmission Services' Application to Intervene is granted.

2. That this order shall become effective on May 3, 1999.
