ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME AND
RESCHEDULING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

The Commission suspended the tariff filed by LCI International Telecom Corporation d/b/a Qwest Communications Services (LCI) on May 18, 1999. In that same order, the Commission directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule on June 25, 1999, and to meet in an early prehearing conference on June 30, 1999. On June 11, 1999, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion to extend the filing deadline for the procedural schedule and to reschedule the prehearing conference.

Counsel for Staff stated that he will be unavailable from June 29, 1999, to July 2, 1999, while attending a seminar, and that counsel for LCI will be out of the country, and thus unavailable from June 14, 1999, to June 24, 1999. Staff requested that the date for filing the procedural schedule be extended to July 27, 1999, and that the prehearing conference be rescheduled to July 7, 1999. Staff stated that LCI has no objection to the request. No responses to Staff's motion were filed.

The Commission has determined that Staff's request is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, the Commission will extend the date

for filing a procedural schedule and reschedule the pre-hearing conference as ordered below.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's Motion to Extend Filing of Procedural Schedule and Modify PreHearing Conference Date is granted.

2. That the Commission will conduct an early prehearing conference on July 7, 1999, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commission's offices on the fifth floor of the Harry S Truman State Office Building, 301 West High Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.

3. That anyone wishing to attend the prehearing conference who has special needs as addressed by the Americans with Disabilities Act should contact the Missouri Public Service Commission at least ten (10) days before the prehearing or hearing at one of the following numbers: Consumer Services Hotline 1-800-392-4211 or TDD Hotline 1-800-829-7541.

4. That the parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than July 27, 1999.

5. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 1999.
