### PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc. d/b/a Snappy Phone, a Texas corporation, by and through its attorneys, Hendren and Andrae, L.L.C., Richard S. Brownlee, III, and for its proposed procedural schedule states:

1. Snappy Phone anticipates filing a unanimous Joint Stipulation and Agreement on or before March 31, 2000. This unanimous Joint Stipulation and Agreement should alleviate the need for any further procedural schedule in this case.

2. In the unlikely event a unanimous Joint Stipulation and Agreement is not filed by the parties on or before March 31, 2000 Snappy Phone proposes the following procedural schedule:

3. Counsel for Snappy Phone has contacted counsel for the Commission Staff and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and neither has any objection to the procedural schedule proposed herewith.
