ORDER CANCELING PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

On October 30, 2020, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificate to provide payphone service granted to Sprint Payphone Services, Inc., the predecessor of Embarq Payphone Services, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc. (CenturyLink) in File No. TA-98-246, on January 5, 1998.

Staff states in its motion that CenturyLink notified Staff on October 24, 2020, that it wished to relinquish its certificate to provide private payphone service in Missouri. Staff indicates CenturyLink's request to cancel its Certificate is in compliance with Commission rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011(3), and asks the Commission to cancel that Certificate.

On October 30, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order Establishing Time to Respond* allowing parties until November 9, to object or to request a hearing. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be

altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on the company’s request and Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate to provide private payphone service granted to CenturyLink shall be canceled.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate to provide private payphone services granted to Sprint Payphone Services, Inc., the predecessor of Embarq Payphone Services, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink Public Communications, Inc., in File Number TA-98-246, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on December 10, 2020.
3. This file may be closed on December 11, 2020.
