

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO RESPOND**

On November 13, 2000, the Missouri Independent Telephone Group (MITG) filed a motion challenging Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's (SWBT's) classification of certain documents as proprietary or highly confidential. MITG asks the Commission to order that those documents be reclassified as non-proprietary. Paragraph B of the protective order that was entered in this case provides that when a motion is filed challenging the designation of documents as confidential, the party designating the information confidential has five days in which to file a response. Since MITG's motion was filed on November 13, SWBT's response would be due on November 18.

On November 15, SWBT filed a motion requesting additional time in which to respond to MITG's motion to declassify. The motion indicates that the attorney handling this matter for SWBT is out of the office through the time when a response would be due. SWBT indicates that it is prepared to file its response on or before November 27. The motion also indicates that SWBT has contacted the attorney for MITG and represents that MITG does not object to allowing SWBT an additional week to respond so long as the response is filed by November 27.

The Commission finds that SWBT's request for additional time to respond is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The motion will be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Motion of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company for Additional Time to Respond to MITG's Motion to Declassify is granted.

2. That Southwestern Bell Telephone Company shall file its response to the Missouri Independent Telephone Group's Motion to Declassify on or before November 27, 2000.

3. That this order shall become effective on November 20, 2000.
