ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On December 4, 1989, American Communications, Inc. (American) submitted a tariff to the Commission which proposed a new competitive intraLATA (Band 0) rate for its Dial 1-2-3 service. American requested that the rate be effective for service on or after January 1, 1990.

On December 15, 1989, Commission Staff filed a recommendation recommending the Commission approve the tariff on less than 30 days notice staff stated that the Band 0 rate represents a decrease of 17.2 percent for intraLATA calls placed by American's subscribers. In addition, Staff states that American is establishing a rate for calls by credit cards.

The Commission has considered the proposed tariff and has determined that it is reasonable and will be approved. The reduction in rates will be beneficial to American's subscribers and there is good cause to allow this reduction to begin on January 1, 1990.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That tariff sheet P.S.C. Mo. No. 4, Revised Sheet No. 18, of American Communications, Inc., is hereby approved to become effective January 1, 1990. ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the 1st day of

January, 1990.
