ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On January 4, 1991, Henry L. Giese, d/b/a Knobview Telephone Company (Company) applied for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service. The Commission granted said certificate on December 18, 1991. On January 31, 1992, Company filed its proposed tariff. Staff then recommended suspending said tariff, which the Commission did by its order of March 11, 1992.

On April 6, 1992, Company, following discussions with the Commission Staff, withdrew its tariff and submitted a substitute tariff on April 6, 1992 with a stated effective date of May 15, 1992.

On May 11, 1992, the Commission Staff filed its recommendation. Staff recommends that Company's tariff filed on April 6, 1992 be approved for service rendered on and after May 15, 1992.

Having considered Company's proposed tariff and Staff's favorable recommendation regarding same, the Commission finds that said tariff is reasonable and complies with the Commission's previous order by which Company obtained its certificate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the tariff filed on April 6, 1992 by Henry L. Giese, d/b/a
 Knobview Telephone Company is hereby approved for service rendered on and after
 May 15, 1992.

That this order shall be effective on May 15, 1992.
