ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS

On September 22, 1994, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWB) submitted proposed tariffs designed to comply with the statutory requirements of Section 386.315.3, RSMo Supp. 1994. The proposed tariffs increase rates for certain SWB services with a total revenue effect of \$15 million and they reflect the adoption of Financial Accounting Standards 106. SWB requested the tariffs be approved on an expedited basis to become effective for service on and after October 1, 1994. This docket was established for the Commission to consider the request for expedited approval and the reasonableness of the tariffs.

Also, on September 22, 1994, Commission Staff filed a memorandum with regard to the proposal. Staff recommends the Commission approve the tariffs and indicates the tariffs are in compliance with Section 386.315.3. Staff indicates the revenue increase will be recovered through an increase in rates for TouchTone service, for access charges and for toll services.

The Commission has reviewed the proposed tariffs and find they should be approved. Based upon Staff's review, the tariffs are in compliance with Section 386.315.3 and will also reflect the reduction in rates approved by the Commission in Case No. TC-93-224. The Commission also finds there is good cause to allow the tariffs to go into effective in less than thirty days since the

approval of the tariffs will result in rate reduction rather than a rate increase since the \$15 million revenue effect will be implemented simultaneously with the revenue reductions in Case No. TC-93-224. The Commission also will adopt the conditions contained in Staff's recommendation in order for SWB to comply with the funding provisions of Section 386.315.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariffs submitted by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on September 22, 1994, to increase rates by \$15 million to comply with Section 386.315.3, RSMo 1994, are hereby approved for service on and after October 1, 1994. The tariff sheets approved are:
