This is especially so where as in the recent filing confirms, the caselaw indicated PSC may not even have the authority to make the determination sought in the 9-30 amended complaint, namely that PSC should defer to the courts, even where based on known caselaw and where there is a clear distinction between rate make authority and any complaint authority and there would need to be expressly mention in the statute to supplant common remedies.

The commission is a body of limited jurisdiction and has only such power as are conferred upon it by the statutes and such incidental powers as may be necessary to enable the commission to exercise the power granted ... The Public Service Commission is an administrative body and not a court and hence the commission has no power to exercise or perform a judicial functions or to promulgate an order requiring a pecuniary reparation or refund .. The commission as no power to declare of enforce any principle of law or equity .

As in Wilshire, supra p .905

(while) .. That Commission does have exclusive jurisdiction over all utility rates but when a controversy arises over the construction of a contractor of a rate schedulee upon which a contract is based , and a claim of an overcharge is made, only the courts can require an accounting or render a judgment for an overcharge, The Public Service Commission cannot" enforce, construe or annul contracts nor can it enter a money judgment ..

As in Fee Fee Trunk, supra at p 468

The Commission is a creature of the legislature and has only such powers as are expressly conferred upon it by statute and those reasonably incident thereto. It may not perform the judicial function. It has no power to determine damages. award pecuniary relief or declare or enforce any principle of law or equity citing Straube v Bowling Green 350 Mo 132(1950) (wherein it having been held—if the question concerned only property rights "jurisdiction to determine these rights is vested in the circuit court The Public Service Commission has no jurisdiction of such a controversy).

As in Gaines v Gibbs, at 543

The Public Service Commission is not a court ,, and has no power to construe or enforce contracts .. declare, enforce. The Commission does not exercise judicial power or authority...
