Dear Judge Woodruff:

On April 27, 2011, AT&T Mobility ("AT&T") notified Grand River Mutual Telephone Corp. d/b/a GRM Networks ("GRM") that it planned to terminate the Agreement between AT&T's affiliate Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc., and GRM. According to AT&T's letter, Dobson will continue to operate in Missouri as an affiliate of New Cingular Wireless PCS ("Cingular") and exchange traffic with GRM under the Cingular Interconnection Agreement. A copy of AT&T's notification letter is included with this letter as Attachment A.

Because the Interconnection Agreement between Dobson and GRM has been terminated, GRM requests that the Commission acknowledge the termination of the Interconnection Agreement and update the Commission's case records and Data Center information accordingly.
