

Please find enclose the application for certification and the proposed Tariff (eleven sheets) of American Entertainment, Inc. d/b/a/ Citylink of Kansas City. The enclosed documents have been prepared based upon discussions by Mr. Lisman of Citylink with Bill Voight in your office regarding the general operation of this service. Citylink of Kansas City is requesting an effective date of February 10, 2000.

Citylink of Kansas City's mission is to provide affordable lowcost intraLATA long distance service to all interested customers regardless of income level or credit worthiness through prepaid service. Citylink of Kansas City is an optional add-on service intended for those who would save money on local long distance through it's use, and is not seeking certification as a primary provider of local or long distance service.

Citylink of Kansas City shall provide service in the State of Missouri and in Kansas within the Kansas City LATA. All calls are handled through Company operated equipment in St. Joseph, Missouri and Kansas City, Missouri. Customers access the service by dialing a seven (7) digit local access number. The customer is identified as an active member either by incoming number recognition or by entering an authorization PIN number. The customer then enters the area code and number and the call is completed by the Company's equipment by relaying the number through local plus.

Also find enclosed American Entertainment, Inc.'s certificate of good standing, certified copy of Articles of Incorporation, and their Fictitious name Registration as Citylink of Kansas City.

# **APPLICATION**

American Entertainment, Inc. d/b/a Citylink of Kansas City, a Missouri Corporation,

files this verified application respectfully requesting that the Missouri Public Service

Commission issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Missouri Revised Statutes.
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant.
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to \$392.420, R.S.MO (1994, as amended).

In support of it's request, Applicant states:

1. The legal name and principle office or place of business of the applicant are:

3. Applicant will provide intraLATA interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and Kansas within the Kansas City LATA. All calls are handled through Company operated equipment located in St. Joseph, Missouri and Kansas City, Missouri.

4. Applicant's proposed tariff is filed with the application. The proposed tariff, which has a 45 day effective date, contains the rules and regulations applicable to it's customers, a description of the services offered, and a list of rates associated with such services.

5. Applicant requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. Applicant believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lessor degree of regulation. Granting of this application will allow greater price and service options for telephone users.

6. Applicant also requests, pursuant to §392.420, R.S.MO (1994, as amended), that the Commission waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as it relates to the regulation of Applicant:







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### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

### OF

### AMERICAN ENTERTAINMENT, INC.

I, the undersigned, being a natural person of the ege of twenty-one (21) years or more and subscriber to the shares of the corporation to be organized pursuant hereto for the general purpose of forming a corporation under the "General and Business Corporation Act of Missouri", hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

### ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is AMERICAN ENTERTAINMENT, INC.

### ARTICLE TWO

The address of its initial registered office in the State of Missouri is 1125 Grand Avenue, Suite #1616, Kansas City, Missouri and the name of the registered agent at that address is R. Britt Carlson.

### ARTICLE THREE

The aggregate number of shares of all classes of stock which the corporation shall have authority to issue is 30,000 shares, all of which will be common stock having a par value of \$10.00 per share. All shares shall have full voting rights. SEC OF STATE

### ARTICLE FOUR

The number of shares of stock to be issued before the corporation shall commence business is 500, and the consideration to be paid therefor and the capital withwhich the corporation shall commence business is \$5,000, all of said shares of stock having been bona fide subscribed and fully paid up in lawful money of the United States in the sum of \$5,000, and said property is in the custody of the person hereinafter referred to as the incorporator.

### ARTICLE FIVE

The name and place of residence for the shareholder and the number of shares subscribed by him are:

### ARTICLE SIX

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall consist of four (4) persons, who shall be elected at the first meeting of the shareholders. The property and business of the corporation shall be managed and controlled by the Board of Directors.

### ARTICLE SEVEN

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The duration and number of years the corporation is to continue shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE EIGHT

### The purpose for which the Corporation is formed is as follows:

To operate a tavern, nightclub, cocktail lounge and any other type of drinking establishment to buy and sell intoxicating liquors, food supplies and equipment and all related materials, and to do any and all acts necessary or incidental to operate such business.

To have, own, buy, lease, rent, mortgage or sell real and personal property, and to give, take, own and make notes, bonds, debentures, mortgages, deeds and deeds of trust, stock and debentures, including stock in this corporation;

To enter into any lawful arrangement for sharing profits, union of interest reciprocal association or cooperative association with any corporation, association, partnership, individual or legal entity for the carrying on of any business, and to enterinto any general or limited partnership, the purpose of which is similar to the purposes set forth in these articles;

To buy, lease, or otherwise acquire, so far as may be permitted by law, the whole or any part of the business, good will, and assets of any person, firm, association or corporation, either foreign or domestic, engaged in a business of the same general character as that for which this corporation is organized;

To endorse, guarantee and secure the payment and satisfaction of bonds, coupons, mortgages, deeds of trust, debentures, securities, obligations and evidences of indebtedness; and also to guarantee and secure the payment or satisfaction of interest on obligations and of dividends on shares of the capital stock of other corporations; or to assume the whole or any part of the liabilities, existing or prospective, of any persons, corporation, firm or association, and to aid in any manner any other person or corporation with which it has business dealings, or whose stocks, bonds or other obligations are held or are in any manner guaranteed by the corporation, and to aid in any manner any other person or corporation, and to do any other act or thing for the preservation, protection, improvement or enhancement of the value of such stocks, bonds, or other obligations;

Without any particular limiting of the objects and powers of the corporation, it is hereby expressly declared and provided that the corporation shall have power to do all things hereinabove enumerated, and also to issue or exchange stocks, bonds or other obligations in payment for property purchased or acquired by it, or for any other object in or about its business, to borrow money without limit, to mortgage or pledge its franchises, real or personal property, income and profits accuring to it, any stocks, bonds or other obligation, or any property which may be acquired by it, and to assure any bonds or other obligations by it issued or incurred; To carry on any business whatsoever which the corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or which may be calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interests of the corporation or to exchange the value of its property; to conduct its business in this state, in other states, in the District of Columbia, in the territories and colonies of the United States, and in foreign countries, and to hold, purchase, mortgage, and convey real and personal property, either in or cut of the State of Missouri, and to have and to exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of Missouri upon corporations formed under the Act pursuant to and under which this corporation is formed;

To make all contracts or agreements necessary to effectuate or assist in the transaction of any such business; to make all mortgages of real or personal property; to purchase, lease, exchange, assign, rent, or otherwise acquire or dispose of any real or personal property which the corporation may think necessary or desirable, or with all or any part of the corporation's property to borrow or raise money and to invest such money so raised in any investments as aforesaid; to do all things in connection with such business which may at any time appear expedient or conducive to the operation or management of the corporation.
