

**ORDER GRANTING SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE**  
**COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

On March 14, 2001, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) filed a motion asking the Commission to extend the briefing schedule previously established for this case. SWBT asks that the date for filing initial briefs be extended from March 16, 2001 to March 23, 2001. SWBT also asks that the date for filing reply briefs be extended from March 30, 2001 to April 6, 2001. SWBT indicates that this change is needed because counsel for SWBT is pressed for time as a result of other cases pending before the Commission. SWBT indicates that all parties have been contacted and that none object to the extension of the briefing schedule.

Because there is no operation of law date by which time the Commission must act in this case, and because the motion is not opposed by any party, the Commission finds that the requested extension of the briefing schedule is reasonable. SWBT's motion will be granted.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**


1. That the Motion for Extension filed by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company is granted.
