ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On October 22, 1991, Alternate Communications Technology, Inc. (Company) was granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service conditional upon approval of Company's tariff. Company first submitted its proposed tariffs on November 18, 1991. Following discussions with Staff, it resubmitted substitute pages thereof on December 9 and December 13, 1991.

On December 23, 1991, the Commission Staff filed its recommendation regarding said tariffs. Staff recommends that the Commission approve said tariffs for service on and after January 1, 1992, the stated effective date of said tariffs. Having considered Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that said tariffs are reasonable and will be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed herein on November 18, 1991, and on December 9 and December 13, 1991, by Alternate Communications Technology, Inc., "P.S.C. Mo. No. 1", are hereby approved for service rendered on and after January 1, 1992.

2. That this order shall become effective on the 1st day of January, 1992.
