### ORDER DIRECTING FILING

Powercom Corporation (Powercom) filed an Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on November 30, 1999, for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392<sup>1</sup> of the Missouri Revised Statutes.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(B) requires all applications to the Commission to include a "...brief statement of the character of business performed by [the] applicant." Powercom did not include a brief statement of the character of the business performed by the applicant in its application as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(B).

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Powercom Corporation shall file a brief statement of the character of the business performed by the applicant as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(B) no later than 3:00 p.m. on December 13, 1999.
