ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION

On March 24, 2000, Universal Telecom, Inc. (UTI), applied for a certificate of service authority to provide prepaid basic local telecommunications service in the State of Missouri. Pursuant to an Order Directing Filing, UTI amended its application to include a request for waiver of the requirement to file its tariff with the application.

On May 30, 2000, UTI filed a request for an extension of time to provide financial information. UTI indicated in its filing that the Financial Analysis Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission had requested additional information from the company and had requested that it be filed by June 1, 2000. On June 12, 2000, UTI filed a request to further amend its application. UTI requested that the Commission allow it to substitute financial statements for the company from January through May of 2000 and pro forma from June 2000 through May 2001 for Exhibit D attached to its original application.



¹ Because the Commission had not ordered UTI to file its financial information in the official case file, the Commission need not rule on UTI's motion for extension of time.

The Commission finds that the additional financial information will be helpful and necessary in determining whether UTI should be granted a certificate of service authority to provide telecommunications service in Missouri. Therefore, the Commission will grant UTI leave to amend its application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Universal Telecom, Inc., is granted leave to amend its application by substituting the financial information filed on June 12, 2000, for its original Exhibit D.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 7, 2000.


