## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE AND AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL AND CANCELLATION OF TARIFFS

On August 5, 1999, the Public Service Commission issued an order approving the application filed by Primus Telecommunications, Inc. (Primus) and Telegroup, Inc. (Telegroup) for authority to transfer to Primus the assets (including customer base) of Telegroup. The application represented that upon completion of the transfer of assets, Telegroup would no longer provide telecommunications service in Missouri. The application also indicated that Telegroup would notify the Commission of its intent to cancel its existing certificate after the transaction was complete.

On December 23, 1999, Primus and Telegroup filed a motion indicating that the assets of Telegroup have been transferred to Primus, and that Primus has assumed responsibility for serving Telegroup's customers in Missouri. Telegroup requests that its certificate to provide resold intrastate interexchange telecommunications services be canceled. Telegroup also requests that it be permitted to withdraw and

cancel its presently filed and effective tariffs. No other party has filed a response to Primus and Telegroup's motion.

Because Telegroup has ceased operations, its certificate and tariffs should be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Certificate of Service Authority granted to Telegroup, Inc. in Case No. TA-92-172 is canceled.
- 2. That Telegroup, Inc. is authorized to withdraw and cancel its presently filed and effective tariffs.
  - 3. That this order shall become effective on January 21, 2000.
  - 4. That this case may be closed on January 24, 2000.
