ORDER DIRECTING FILING
AND CLOSING CASE

On April 8, 1999, the Commission by order approved the application of Central Missouri Telecommunications, Inc. (Applicant or CMT), for certificates of service authority to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications services. That order directed that Applicant:

shall file tariff sheets with a minimum 45-day effective date reflecting the rates, rules, regulations and the services it will offer within 30 days after the effective date of a Commission order approving an interconnection agreement which will allow CMT to provide services. The tariff shall be filed in Case No. TA-99-317 and shall include a listing of the statutes and Commission rules waived above.

However, the Commission has determined that this case need not be held open waiting for CMT to file its tariffs. CMT shall instead file its tariffs in the case in which the Commission enters an order approving an interconnection agreement which will allow CMT to provide services.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Central Missouri Telecommunications, Inc., shall file tariff sheets with a minimum 45-day effective date reflecting the rates, rules, regulations and the services it will offer within 30 days after the effective date of a Commission order approving an interconnection agreement which will allow it to provide services. The tariff shall be filed in the case in which the Commission issues the order approving an interconnection agreement and shall include a listing of the statutes and Commission rules waived in Case No. TA-99-317.

2. That this order shall be effective on June 8, 1999.

3. That this case may be closed on June 9, 1999.
