### ORDER APPROVING TARIFFS PURSUANT TO COMMISSION ORDER

On June 23, 1999, UtiliCorp United Inc., d/b/a Missouri Public Service (MPS), submitted tariff sheets pursuant to an Order Approving Transfer issued May 21, 1999. MPS submitted substitute sheets on July 6, 1999. On June 11, 1999, Missouri Gas Energy, a Division of Southern Union Company (MGE), filed a letter in which it stated that it believed that its tariffs needed no modification to reflect the transfer approved in this case.

On July 12, 1999, the Staff of the Commission filed its memorandum in which it states that it has reviewed MPS's tariffs, finds that they are correct and comply with the Commission's order, and recommends approval. Staff also states that it agrees with MGE that no modification to its tariffs is necessary.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff filing, MGE's letter, and the Staff memorandum and has determined the filing to be in compliance with the Commission's order.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Tariff No. 9901011, filed June 23, 1999, by UtiliCorp United Inc., d/b/a Missouri Public Service, is hereby approved for service on or after July 26, 1999.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 26, 1999.
  - 3. That this case may be closed on July 27, 1999.
