ORDER REGARDING FILING

On May 21, 1999, Eagle Communications Group, Inc. (Eagle) filed its Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Interexchange Telecommunications Services and Private Pay Telephone Service in the State of Missouri. This filing will be accepted as an application for certificate ο£ service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services only. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(3) requires that all applications for certificate interexchange service authority to provide customer-owned coin telephone (COCT) service shall be filed on the form provided by the Commission.

Eagle's request for a certificate of interexchange service authority to provide COCT service shall be stricken as it fails to comply with the Commission rule. Applicant may refile its application for a certificate of interexchange service authority to provide COCT service in a manner which complies with rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(3).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

 That Eagle Communications Group, Inc.'s request for a certificate of interexchange service authority to provide customerowned coin telephone service filed on May 21, 1999, is stricken.

- 2. Eagle Communications Group, Inc. is permitted to refile its request for a certificate of interexchange service authority to provide customer-owned coin telephone service in a manner which complies with rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(3).
 - That this order shall become effective on June 28, 1999.
