COMPLIANCE WITH COMMISSION ORDER

The Commission approved an interconnection agreement between Logix and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company on December 1. Logix requested and the Commission approved the extension of the date for filing of the tariff sheets from January 11 to March 12, 1999. Logix filed tariff sheets on March 12, with an effective date of April 26, reflecting the rates, rules, and regulations it will use and the services it will offer. After several extensions of the effective

date of its tariff, Logix extended the effective date of its proposed tariff to October 20. Logix filed a substitute tariff consisting of 21 pages, which replaced the previously filed tariff in its entirety on May 19 and September 20. Logix filed substitute sheets for the September 20 proposed tariff on October 1 and October 4.

The Commission's Staff reviewed the tariff sheets and filed a memorandum on October 6 recommending that the Commission approve them as amended by the substitute sheets. Staff stated that Logix proposes to offer basic local exchange service to business customers on a resale basis, and to offer E-911 Services, Local Operator Assistance, Directory Assistance, place or receive calls within the SWBT exchanges listed beginning on sheet 9 of its proposed tariff, Auto Redial, Call Return, Call Waiting, Call Trace, Caller ID, and Three Way Calling. Staff noted that Logix's proposed tariff includes operator service requirement language previously approved by the Commission. Staff also stated that Logix's proposed tariff states that Logix does not restrict its customers from choosing an interexchange carrier. Staff reported that Logix's proposed tariff does not contain charges for providing intrastate switched access service to interexchange carriers due to the fact that Logix is a reseller precluded from charging for switched access service. Staff stated that it is not aware of any other filings that would affect or be affected by this filing. Staff recommended that the tariff be approved as amended to become effective on October 20, 1999.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets, as amended, conform

to the Commission's order issued September 17, 1998 and should be approved to become effective on October 20, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff, Tariff File No. 9900675, filed by Logix Communications Corporation f/k/a Dobson Wireless, Inc. on March 12, 1999, is approved as amended to become effective on October 20, 1999. The tariff approved is:
