**ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES**

On April 9, 1999, the Commission consolidated Case Nos. TO-99-254 and TO-99-125 and established a new procedural schedule. On April 22, in response to an order issued on March 23 by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), most local exchange carriers (LECs) filed their plans for implementing intraLATA toll dialing parity (ILDTP).

On May 14, 1999, Winstar Wireless, Inc. filed its plan and that filing was assigned Case No. TO-99-559. Since TO-99-559 involves common questions of law and fact with TO-99-254 et al., the Commission will consolidate the cases.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Case No. TO-99-559 is consolidated for hearing purposes with Case Nos. TO-99-254 et al. Case No. TO-99-254 shall be the lead case.

2. That this order shall become effective on May 31, 1999.
