ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE

On January 12, 1999, the Commission approved the Stipulation and NEXTLINK MISSOURI, INC. (NEXTLINK). The Agreement filed by Commission's order conditionally granted NEXTLINK's request for a certificate of service authority to provide basic exchange and local The order also directed NEXTLINK to exchange telecommunications. submit its tariffs for Commission review within 30 days of the effective date of the order approving NEXTLINK's interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT).

On April 23, NEXTLINK filed its Motion for Extension of Time to File Tariffs with the Commission. NEXTLINK indicated that its interconnection agreement with SWBT in Case No. TO-99-270 was approved by the Commission effective February 23, 1999. NEXTLINK stated that it has not yet filed tariffs for the Commission's review in part due to continuing negotiations with SWBT on the terms of a modified interconnection agreement. NEXTLINK requested an additional 20 days submit tariffs and including May 11, 1999 to Commission's review. NEXTLINK stated that no party will be prejudiced if additional time is granted to NEXTLINK for the filing of its tariffs. As no party objected to this request, the Commission will extend the time for NEXTLINK to file its tariff to May 11, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Motion for Extension of Time to File Tariffs filed by NEXTLINK MISSOURI, INC. on April 23, 1999 is granted. NEXTLINK MISSOURI, INC. is ordered to file its proposed tariff sheets no later than May 11, 1999.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on May 4, 1999.
