ORDER DIRECTING FILING OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 11, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing of Additional Information, which required Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC ("Grain Belt Express") to file additional documents and information. On April 13, 2015, Grain Belt Express filed its response in compliance with that order, including twenty-one new supplemental exhibits.

In its previous order, the Commission stated that it would invite comments from the parties regarding a procedure for offering such additional information into the record, a time for responses or objections, and, if necessary, an opportunity for new testimony. The order also set a 30-day deadline for responses to the information. Before establishing a supplemental procedural schedule regarding the new information, the Commission will provide an opportunity for the parties to comment or make recommendations on an appropriate procedure for addressing the information filed by Grain Belt Express.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to comment or make recommendations on an appropriate procedure for addressing the information filed by Grain Belt Express shall do so no later than April 22, 2015.
