ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Cable & Wireless Global Markets, Inc. (CWGM) applied to the Public Service Commission on June 3, 1999, for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Section 392.440, RSMo 1994¹. CWGM asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive rules certain statutes and as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392,420. CWGM is a Delaware corporation, with its principal office located at 1275 Pennsylvania Avenue N.W., Washington, DC 20004.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications and Opportunity to Intervene on June 15, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by June 30. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. <u>State ex rel.</u> <u>Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission</u>, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has asked JK

permission to intervene or requested a hearing, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the verified application.

CWGM filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application and filed substitute sheets on July 16 and 22. The tariff's proposed effective date is August 2. CWGM's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies CWGM as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested.

In its Memorandum filed on July 22, the Staff of the Commission recommended that the Commission grant CWGM a certificate of service authority, competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff as amended to become effective on August 2.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange telecommunications market is in the public interest and CWGM should be granted a certificate of service authority. The Commission finds that the services CWGM proposes to offer are competitive and CWGM should be classified as a competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that CWGM's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer, and is similar to tariffs approved for other Missouri certificated interexchange carriers. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on June 3 shall be approved as amended to become effective on August 2.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Cable & Wireless Global Markets, Inc. is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.

2. That Cable & Wireless Global Markets, Inc. is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:
