**ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND TARIFF**

On January 12, 1998, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) received a letter from Greg Spicer, Director of TW Communications, Inc. d/b/a TWC (TWC), indicating that the company wished to surrender its authority to provide telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

The Staff of the Commission (Commission) filed a memorandum containing its recommendation on February 4, 1998. Staff states that TWC was certificated by the Commission to provide interexchange telecommunications service on July 18, 1995, in Case No. TA-95-236. Staff adds that TWC discontinued providing service in Missouri effective November 1, 1997. Based upon TWC's request, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel the certificate of service authority previously granted to TWC, along with its accompanying tariff.

The Commission has reviewed the letter from TWC and Staff's recommendation, and finds that it would be inappropriate to continue in full force and effect a certificate of service of service authority or tariff for a company which is no longer transacting business in the State

of Missouri. Based upon Staff's recommendation, the Commission will thus cancel the certificate of service authority and tariff for TWC.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificate of service authority previously granted to TW Communications, Inc. d/b/a TWC on July 18, 1995 in Case No. TA-95-236, along with its accompanying tariff, are hereby canceled.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 2, 1998.
