In the matter of the application of Lakewood Manor, Limited, for permission, approval, and a certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system for the public, located in an unincorporated area in Barry County, Missouri.) ORDER APPROVING ORIGINAL TARIFF

By its Order Granting application in this case effective December 29, 1989, this Commission ordered Lakewood Manor, Limited to file a complete tariff for water service as authorized in this case.

On February 27, 1990, Lakewood Manor, Limited submitted an original tariff for Commission review and approval, to comply with the Commission's Order.

The Commission is of the opinion the proposed tariff submitted February 27, 1990 complies with its Order effective December 29, 1989, and said tariff should be allowed to become effective for water service rendered on and after April 1, 1990.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the tariff, consisting of the following sheets, submitted February 27, 1990, by Lakewood Manor, Limited for water service be, and they are, hereby approved and made effective for water service rendered on and after April 1, 1990:
