ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On October 6, 1993, Hedges & Associates, Inc., d/b/a Dial U.S. (Dial U.S. or Applicant) submitted a tariff filing in which it requested changes for its US Wats calling plan. These proposed changes would not affect the rates charged to US Wats customers, but would allow new customers to sign up for longer term agreements should they wish to do so.

On October 22, 1993, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its Memorandum in which it recommended approval of this tariff. The tariff is proposing to allow customers to sign up for longer term agreements under the US Wats Plan; however, all existing US Wats customers would be "grandfathered" under their existing agreements.

After considering the tariff filing and the Staff's recommendation, the Commission is of the opinion that this proposed change should be approved. This tariff filing would appear to offer enhanced service options which the customer would remain free to elect at the customer's option.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheet filed by Hedges & Associates, Inc., d/b/a Dial U.S. on October 6, 1993, is hereby approved for service on and after November 8, 1993:
