ORDER AND NOTICE CLOSING CASE

Navigator Telecommunications, LLC (Navigator), applied to the Commission on September 28, 1999, to amend its certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in the state of Missouri (the application filed on September 28, 1999, was verified; an earlier application filed on September 21, 1999, was not verified). Navigator was granted a certificate of service authority in Case No. TA-98-383 and is certified to provide basic local exchange services in the portions of Missouri served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT).

Navigator sought to amend its certificate to allow the provision of basic local exchange and local exchange telecommunications service on a facilities and resold basis throughout all exchanges currently served by the incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies of SWBT, Sprint/United Telephone Company (Sprint), and GTE Midwest, Inc. (GTE). The Commission issued an Order Amending Certificate to Provide Basic Local Telecommunications Services on December 8, 1999. Under the order, Navigator's amended certificate does not become effective until revised or amended tariffs are filed and subsequently approved. No tariff revisions or amendments have been filed in this case.

Navigator's amended certificate will not be effective until such time as it files and obtains approval for a revised or amended tariff. No further action is required in this case. The Commission will not hold a case open indefinitely. Therefore, this case shall be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That this case shall be closed effective June 16, 2000.
- 3. That this order shall become effective on June 16, 2000.
