ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc. d/b/a Snappy Phone (Snappy Phone) applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission on December 15, 1999, for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Sections 392.420 - .440, RSMo 1994¹, and Sections 392.410 and .450, RSMo Supp. 1999. The Commission issued an Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local and Interexchange Telecommunications Services on April 28, 2000. The Commission provided that the certificate would become effective when the Company's tariff became effective.

On April 18, 2000, Snappy Phone filed a Basic Local Service Tariff with the Commission in this case and the Commission assigned this tariff file number 200000957. Snappy Phone withdrew this tariff on May 19, 2000. On May 23, 2000, Snappy Phone again filed a tariff. The tariff file number assigned by the Commission is 200001066. The tariff has an issue date of May 23, 2000, and an original effective date of July 7, 2000. On June 20, 2000, Snappy Phone filed a substitute for this tariff.

The Commission's April 28, 2000, order directed Staff to file its recommendation regarding the tariff to be filed in this case no later than seven working days prior to the effective date of the tariff. Staff filed its recommendation on June 26, 2000.

Staff stated that Snappy Phone's interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and Pacific Bell was approved by the Commission on May 21, 2000. Staff indicates that Snappy Phone's tariff is similar to other tariffs approved by the Commission for other competitive local exchange carriers providing prepaid resold telecommunications services to residential customers. Staff stated that it believes Snappy Phone's proposed tariff complies with the Commission's orders. Staff stated that it has no objection to the Commission approving Snappy Phone's tariff sheets as amended.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff should be approved to become effective as ordered below. Snappy Phone's certificate of authority to provide basic local telecommunications services shall become effective with the tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff filed by Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc. d/b/a Snappy Phone, on May 23, 2000, and assigned tariff number 200001066, as amended, is approved to become effective on July 7, 2000. The tariff approved is:
