

**ORDER CANCELING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND HEARING**

On April 7, 2000, the parties filed a stipulation and agreement that purports to resolve the outstanding issues in this case. The Commission will consider that stipulation and agreement in due course. With the filing of the unanimous stipulation and agreement, the remaining procedural schedule becomes unnecessary.

The Commission also notes that the applicant filed a fidelity bond on April 7, 2000. On April 18, 2000, the applicant submitted its tariff to the Commission with an issue date of April 18, 2000, and an effective date of June 2, 2000. The Commission's Staff will be directed to file suggestions regarding the stipulation and agreement and fidelity bond and a recommendation regarding the proposed tariff.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the procedural schedule previously established for this case is canceled.
2. That the hearing scheduled for July 18, 2000, is canceled.

3. That the Commission's Staff shall file its suggestions regarding the stipulation and agreement and the fidelity bond not later than May 10, 2000.

4. That the Commission's Staff shall file its recommendation regarding the applicant's tariff not later than ten days prior to the tariff effective date.

5. That this order shall become effective on May 5, 2000.
