

ORDER SHORTENING TIME IN WHICH TO RESPOND
TO MITG'S MOTION TO COMPEL SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE
COMPANY TO ANSWER DATA REQUESTS

On November 7, 2000, the Missouri Independent Telephone Group (MITG) filed a motion asking that the Commission compel Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) to answer certain data requests submitted to SWBT by MITG. MITG requests that the Commission order SWBT to answer the disputed data requests on or before December 4, 2000.


So that it may consider the MITG's motion promptly, the Commission will, as permitted by 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), shorten the time allowed for the filing of a response to MITG's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That any party wishing to respond to the Missouri Independent Telephone Group's Motion to Compel Southwestern Bell Telephone Company to Answer Data Requests shall do so on or before November 14, 2000.

2. That this order shall become effective on November 14, 2000.
