# **ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTIONS**

Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) filed an application to transfer assets on October 6, 2000. On December 20, 2000, all the parties were present at a prehearing conference. Even though they had not yet requested intervention, counsel for The Doe Run Resources Corporation (Doe Run) and counsel for Barnes-Jewish Hospital, DaimlerChrysler Corporation, The Doe Run Company, Emerson Electric Company, Lone Star Industries Inc., River Cement Company, SSM HealthCare, and Unity Health System (collectively known as the "Missouri Energy Group") were also present at the prehearing conference.

On December 22, 2000, the Missouri Energy Group filed an Application to Intervene. The Missouri Energy Group states that it has an interest in the Commission's decision because each of the companies has purchased "substantial amounts of electricity from Union Electric Company." The Missouri Energy Group also states that its

interests differ from those of the general public and that its intervention would serve the public interest.

On January 5, 2001, Doe Run filed an Application to Intervene. In its application, Doe Run states that it has an interest in the Commission's decision because it is a large customer of AmerenUE and as a large customer its interests differ from those of the general public. Doe Run states that its intervention in this case "would serve the public interest by assisting the development of a more complete record for decision by the Commission."

The Commission has reviewed the applications to intervene filed by the members of the Missouri Energy Group and by Doe Run and finds that they are in substantial compliance with Commission rules regarding intervention. The Commission also finds that each of the applicants has an interest in this matter which is different from that of the general public. The Commission concludes that the requests for intervention should be granted.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the interventions of the members of the Missouri Energy Group are granted.
- 2. That the intervention of The Doe Run Resources Corporation is granted.

3. That this order shall become effective on January 22, 2001.
