## STAFF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for its request, states as follows:

- 1. On August 22, 2011, EveryCall Communications, d/b/a All American Wireless ("EveryCall") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking to expand its designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") for the purpose of receiving federal universal service fund support for low income customers through Lifeline and LinkUp programs as a wireless carrier in the State of Missouri.
- 2. As the Commission is aware, the Staff has recently begun to issue Data Requests to all wireless ETC applicants, which requires a greater time to process than the previous review took.
- 3. The Staff is not yet able to prepare its recommendation, which is due on October 14, 2011. The Staff requests an extension of time in which to conclude its review and investigation, and estimates that its review will take approximately ten weeks from now.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff requests that the Commission extend the time by which the Staff may file its recommendation until Thursday, December 15, 2011.
