## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Issue Date: August 21, 2007 Effective Date: August 21, 2007

On April 9, 2007, Leesa Forsee filed a complaint against Aquila, Inc., claiming that Aquila has overbilled her approximately \$70, and improperly charged her a deposit. Aquila denies her allegations.

Staff filed a report on June 4 that stated that Ms. Forsee had not provided enough information to show that she is entitled to the bill credits. Therefore, Staff recommends that the complaint be dismissed. Ms. Forsee responded on August 17, again asserting that she does not owe the disputed amounts.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. The parties should also be prepared to name the witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing.

Also, the parties should be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

If the parties do not resolve their dispute, they shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. A prehearing conference shall be held on September 10, 2007, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 3. The parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than September 17, 2007.
  - 4. This order shall become effective on August 21, 2007.
