STAFF MOTION TO CANCEL DESIGNATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its motion states as follows:

1. On May 5, 2015, Aegis Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Off The Hook Telecom filed a request to relinquish its Eligible Telecommunication Carrier (“ETC”) designation (see attachment). On October 29, 2011, the Commission granted the Company ETC status in Case No. RA-2011-0349.

2. In lieu of a memorandum, the Staff herein recommends that the Commission grant the Company’s request. The Commission does not have specific rules concerning relinquishing, but relies on 47 USC §214(e)(4). The Staff agrees that the Company meets all of the requirements set forth therein and no longer provides Lifeline service in Missouri.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Aegis Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Off The Hook Telecom’s request to relinquish its designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier for the receipt of low-income support from the federal Universal Service Fund.
