**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**  
**TO FILE RECOMMENDATION**

On April 25, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a pleading stating that it would file a recommendation in this matter by May 31, 2005. Upon Staff's request, the Commission extended the time, until June 30, by which Staff would file its recommendation. On June 30, 2005, Staff filed a second request to extend, until August 1, 2005, the time by which it would file its recommendation.

Staff states that it is unable to file its recommendation because of some remaining issues regarding Timber Creek Sewer Company's recent application to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources for construction and operating permits. Staff further informs the Commission that there are no customers waiting for service in the area the company proposes to serve and that no homes will be constructed in the area prior to the fall of this year.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and, finding it reasonable, will grant the requested relief.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the Staff of the Commission's request to extend the time by which it must file its recommendation is granted.
2. That the Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation in this matter no later than August 1, 2005.
3. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
