ORDER REGARDING REQUEST FOR PARTIAL WAIVER

Issue Date: August 3, 2016 Effective Date: August 3, 2016

On July 12, 2016, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an order directing its Secretary to reject an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity filed by Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC ("Grain Belt") for failing to file the notice (the "60-day notice") required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.020(2) and authorizing Grain Belt to re-file its application after submitting a 60-day notice. In that order the Commission stated that it would consider a request to waive the requirement that Grain Belt wait 60 days from the date of the 60-day notice before re-filing its application because notice of a likely contested case was effectively given as of June 30, 2016, when the original application was filed.

On July 12, 2016, Grain Belt filed a 60-day notice and a *Request for Partial Waiver* of the 60-Day Notice Requirement. In its request, Grain Belt asks the Commission to deem the effective date of the notice as June 30, 2016, thereby allowing Grain Belt to re-file its application any time after August 29, 2016. Ten days have elapsed and no party has

objected to the Grain Belt request.¹ The Commission finds the request reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC's Request for Partial Waiver of the 60-Day Notice Requirement filed on July 12, 2016, is granted.
- 2. Grain Belt Express Clean Line LLC is authorized to file an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity at any time after August 29, 2016.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
