ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME AND DIRECTING FILINGS

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting Total Call Mobile, Inc.'s *Motion for Additional Time to Respond* ("motion") to the *Staff Report and Response to Total Call Mobile's Answer*.

Staff filed the initial pleading¹ on April 14. Total Call filed its response.² Staff filed a reply.³ The motion⁴ asks for time, until September 28, 2016, to file a sur-reply to the reply. Because the reply was four months in the investigation and drafting, the motion is not unreasonable. In addition, a draft order granting provisional suspension is due from Staff on September 30, 2016.⁵ Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion for additional time to file, and will direct Total Call to file a draft order denying provisional suspension, and make both draft orders due on September 30.

3. The parties shall file a joint proposed procedural schedule no later than October 14, 2016.
