ORDER APPROVING TARIFF SHEET

ALLTEL Missouri, Inc. (ALLTEL) filed tariff a sheet pursuant to the Report and Order issued by the Commission in Case No. TO-92-306 on December 23, 1992. The proposed tariff sheet is designed to remove the Neeleyville exchange community optional service (COS) route from ALLTEL's tariff to coincide with the conversion of the route to modified COS. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a memorandum recommending that the Commission approve the tariff sheet for service on and after August 31, 1993.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that ALLTEL's proposed tariff sheet is in compliance with the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. TO-92-306. Thus, the Commission determines that the tariff sheet filed by ALLTEL should be approved for service on and after August 31, 1993.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following tariff sheet filed by ALLTEL Missouri, Inc. is hereby approved for service on and after August 31, 1993:
