ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS AND STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

On December 11, 2020, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed its application seeking an order declining jurisdiction or, alternatively, requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate and maintain interconnection facilities in Schuyler County, Missouri. ATXI's application states the facilities generally consist of a switchyard connecting High Prairie Wind Generation Facility with ATXI's Mark Twain Transmission Line. ATXI requests expedited treatment and a Commission order within 90 days of its application. Finally, ATXI requests a waiver of the Commission's 60-day notice requirement under 20 CSR 4240-4.017.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications. The Commission will also direct Staff to file a recommendation with regard to ATXI's application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's data center shall provide notice of this order and ATXI's application to the county commission for Schuyler County, Missouri.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of ATXI's application to members of the General Assembly representing residents of Schuyler County, Missouri.

3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of ATXI's application to news media serving residents of Schuyler County, Missouri.

4. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than January 4, 2021. Any such filing shall be submitted through the Commission's electronic filing information system or delivered to:

5. No later than January 11, 2021, the Commission's Staff shall file either a recommendation regarding ATXI's application or a status report advising when it expects to file a recommendation.

6. This order shall be effective when issued.
