- 2 JUDGE JONES: On the record with Case
- 3 No. SA-2010-0219, the matter of the application of Canyon
- 4 Treatment Facility for a certificate of convenience and
- 5 necessity authorizing it to manage a sewer system in Stone
- 6 County, Missouri.
- 7 My name is Kennard Jones. I'm presiding
- 8 judge over this case. At this time let's take entries of
- 9 appearances, beginning with Canyon Treatment Facility.
- 10 MR. ENGLAND: Thank you, your Honor. Let
- 11 the record reflect the appearance of W.R. England
- 12 appearing on behalf of Canyon Treatment Facility. My
- 13 mailing address is P.O. Box 456, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 14 65102. Thank you.
- JUDGE JONES: Let me ask now, Mr. Hall,
- 16 were you able to hear Mr. England okay?
- 17 MR. HALL: I was. It was a little -- a
- 18 little soft, but if I can't hear, I'll interject and ask
- 19 folks to speak up a little bit, but I could hear him.
- JUDGE JONES: Next we'll have entry from
- 21 the Staff of the Commission.
- MS. HERNANDEZ: Good morning, your Honor.
- 23 After Mr. England's formalities, maybe I should stand up
- 24 as well.
- 25 Again, this is Jennifer Hernandez, and I

- 1 represent the Staff of the Missouri Public Service
- 2 Commission. And may the record reflect we also have
- 3 Mr. Merciel and Mr. Busch here this morning for our
- 4 discussions.
- 5 JUDGE JONES: And entry from Royal Vista --
- 6 is it Vista or Vista?
- 7 Mr. HALL: Vista, Royal Vista, LLC. My
- 8 name is Ken Hall. I'm an attorney out of Fayetteville,
- 9 Arkansas. I'm licensed in the state of Missouri, and I am
- 10 entering my appearance on behalf of Royal Vista, LLC.
- 11 JUDGE JONES: And from VPG Partners, LLC.
- 12 MR. WOODSMALL: Thank you, your Honor. Let
- 13 the record reflect the appearance of David Woodsmall, the
- 14 firm of Finnegan, Conrad & Peterson, appearing on behalf
- of VPG Partners VI. I previously provided a written
- 16 appearance with my address.
- 17 JUDGE JONES: I'll note for the record that
- 18 the Office of Public Counsel is not present and has not up
- 19 to this point been participating.
- 20 Before I go off the record, I just want
- 21 you-all to be clear about what your disagreement is, and
- 22 I'd like to know, is there disagreement, first of all,
- 23 amongst the parties?
- MR. WOODSMALL: I don't know yet. I would
- 25 note that in our interventions we raised some issues, but

- 1 we haven't had any formalized process to determine if
- 2 those are disagreements or at this point just concerns.
- 3 MS. HERNANDEZ: And maybe that's my part
- 4 since Staff did file the motion for a prehearing
- 5 conference. Just prior to filing a recommendation, the
- 6 Staff felt it appropriate for the parties to get together,
- 7 discuss not only for our purposes that we understand what
- 8 the entire scope of this case is, but also to possibly
- 9 discuss options for moving this case forward, and maybe,
- 10 not to make predictions, it may be more appropriate in
- 11 this case for a Stipulation & Agreement between the
- 12 parties regarding the certificate depending on what issues
- 13 are at hand.
- 14 I think that's about as far as we can go
- 15 with the scope as we know it today.
- 16 JUDGE JONES: So you were just as a
- 17 precautionary measure trying to bring the parties together
- 18 before submitting a rec?
- 19 MS. HERNANDEZ: That's correct. With there
- 20 being intervenors in this case, the Staff just wanted to
- 21 be sure that we understood the full context of the case
- 22 before us.
- JUDGE JONES: Is there anything in
- 24 particular you-all need to discuss on the record before I
- 25 leave you to yourselves?

1 MR. ENGLAND: Judge, on an unrelated
```

- 2 matter, related but unrelated, there is a companion case
- 3 involving a complaint that I believe is assigned to you as
- 4 well.
- JUDGE JONES: Yes.
- 6 MR. ENGLAND: And Staff has an outstanding
- 7 motion to stay the filing of answers in that case pending
- 8 resolution of this case. I don't think anyone has filed
- 9 an opposition that I'm aware of, and I know that there are
- 10 other respondents besides Canyon that have been operating
- 11 under the assumption that, in fact, it will be stayed, but
- 12 there's been no formal order to that effect.
- 13 JUDGE JONES: I'll send something out today
- 14 so we'll have a record of it.
- MR. ENGLAND: Thank you.
- 16 JUDGE JONES: Mr. Hall, did you want to add
- 17 anything on the record before I --
- 18 MR. HALL: No, sir. I agree with what's
- 19 been stated in terms of that there are just some issues
- 20 that in particular were raised by the intervenors,
- 21 including my client, that we want to just discuss and make
- 22 sure that we're all tracking as far as understanding what
- 23 is being asked and how it would work and that type of
- 24 thing.
- 25 JUDGE JONES: Well, with that, then, I
