ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

John Hayes submitted a letter to the Missouri Public Service Commission on May 1, 1997, asking the Commission to cancel the payphone certificate in his and his wife's name as they no longer operate a payphone business in Missouri. The payphone certificate was returned to the Public Service Commission along with this letter. John and Pamela Hayes were granted their certificate on September 15, 1995, in Case No. TA-96-50. The Staff of the Commission advised the Commission that it had attempted to make contact with the certificate holders, were unable to do so, but based on the letter from John Hayes still recommended that the certificate should be canceled.

Section 392.410, RSMo Supp. 1997 gives the Commission authority over the granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed John Hayes' letter and Staff's comments and finds that the private payphone certificate granted to John and Pamela Hayes in Case No. TA-96-50 shall be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the private payphone certificate granted to John and Pamela Hayes in Case No. TA-96-50 is canceled.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on July 23, 1998.

3. That this case may be closed on July 24, 1998.
