On May 15, 2000, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) filed an application with the Commission, requesting that the Commission authorize KCPL to restructure itself to create a holding company, a competitive generation company, a regulated utility company and an unregulated subsidiary. Proper parties should be given notice and an opportunity to intervene in this matter. The Records Department of the Commission shall send a copy of this order to the county commissions for all counties located within the service area of KCPL (Platte, Clay, Jackson, Cass, Lafayette, Saline, Pettis, Carroll, Chariton, Randolph and Howard) and to the city government of Kansas City, Missouri. The Information Officer of the Commission shall send notice of this application to the members of the General Assembly who represent each county located within the service areas of KCPL, and to the newspapers that serve each county

within the service areas of KCPL, as listed in the newspaper directory of the current Official Manual of the State of Missouri. In addition, the Records Department of the Commission shall send notice to all the electric companies regulated by the Commission.

Proper persons wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene with the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission. Copies of the application to intervene should be sent to the parties listed below.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party is granted intervention and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary and that the Applicant may submit its evidence in support of the application by verified statement. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Information Office and the Records Department of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall provide notice as set out herein.
- 2. That any interested person wishing to intervene in this case shall file an application on or before June 15, 2000 with:
