ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 18, 1991, NOS Communications, Inc. (NOS or Applicant) filed an Application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunication services in the state of Missouri. An Order and Notice was issued by the Commission on January 8, 1992 setting an intervention date of February 7, 1992. The Commission order went on to state that if no party requested a hearing the Commission would allow the Applicant to submit evidence in support of its Application by verified statement.

There has been no communication from the Applicant except for a letter received by the Commission on November 19, 1992 which indicated that the Applicant's attorney had now merged with another law firm and that the attorney's address had changed.

There have been no motions, recommendations or any other type of pleadings filed in this case since the Application was filed on December 18, 1991.

The Commission is of the opinion that NOS has abandoned its Application and for that reason the Commission is of the opinion that the case should be dismissed.

1. That Case No. TA-92-133 be hereby dismissed.
