STAFF RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and states:

- 1. On October 25, 2016, Total Call Mobile and the Staff submitted a Stipulation of Dismissal. In it, the parties agreed to allow Total Call Mobile to relinquish its Eligible Telecommunications Carrier status.
- 2. On November 7, 2016, the Commission issued an Order in which it noted that 47 USC 214(e)(4) required that the Commission determine that another ETC was available to continue to provide Lifeline service to the customers of the relinquishing ETC prior to allowing the ETC to relinquish its status.
- 3. Boomerang Wireless, a Missouri ETC, has expressed willingness to take on any Lifeline customer of Total Call Mobile that is willing to transfer to its service. Numerous other ETCs serve the same geographic area, and customers of Total Call Mobile are, of course, free to choose one of those ETCs if they do not wish to be transferred to Boomerang Wireless.

WHEREFORE, the Staff submits its Response.
