- 1 PROCEEDINGS
- JUDGE LANE: It's May 30, 2007 about
- 3 10:05 a.m. I am Benjamin Lane, I am sitting in for
- 4 Judge Nancy Dippell today and will be presiding over
- 5 the on-the-record portion of this procedural
- 6 conference, or pre-hearing conference. Our court
- 7 reporter today is Mindy Vislay. Thank you very much
- 8 for being here.
- 9 This is the Case No. SA-2007-0316 that's
- 10 captioned; in the matter of Missouri-American Water
- 11 Company's application for expansion of its Certificate
- 12 of Convenience and Necessity authorizing it to
- 13 participate in the extension, construction, operation,
- 14 maintenance, removal, replacement, control and
- 15 management of a sewer utility in Platte County,
- 16 Missouri.
- 17 It's my understanding, after having reviewed the
- 18 pleadings in this case, this involves an application
- 19 by Missouri-American Water Company for a Certificate
- 20 of Convenience and Necessity which would expand its
- 21 ability to provide sewer service in Platte County to a
- 22 residential subdivision known as Montebella. There
- 23 was notice issued and an intervention deadline set.
- 24 We did get an intervener; mainly, Platte County
- 25 Regional Sewer District. That application for

- 1 intervention was granted by the Commission's order of
- 2 May 15, and the District has stated that it opposes
- 3 any further extension of Missouri-American service
- 4 area into its jurisdictional area and opposes the
- 5 present application. Therefore, the matter is
- 6 contested and a hearing will be required, should the
- 7 case not settle before then.
- 8 So, we're here at the pre-hearing conference or
- 9 procedural conference. I see it as having two major
- 10 goals. The first one is to provide an opportunity --
- 11 possibly the last/best opportunity -- for the parties
- 12 to pursue settlement discussions, if that's going to
- 13 be possible.
- 14 Please feel free -- and we certainly do encourage
- 15 the parties -- to discuss this case amongst
- 16 yourselves. As you know, nothing that's said in the
- 17 confines of this proceeding, once we go off the
- 18 record, would be admissible into evidence unless it's
- 19 independently verified by other evidence, evidence not
- 20 the result of what happens here today. And if you --
- 21 it appears to me that there may possibly be some basis
- 22 for the parties to compromise, that's not for me to
- 23 say, but I do want to let you know that we certainly
- 24 do encourage settlement of these types of matters if
- 25 possible.

1 The second major thing that we would like to
```

- 2 achieve at this procedural conference is a procedural
- 3 schedule. As you know, the Commission has already
- 4 ordered a procedural schedule to be filed, either
- 5 separately or jointly, by June 6th, 2007. We have
- 6 this room and this line available to five o'clock
- 7 today, so that ought to be plenty of time to hash-out,
- 8 or at least get the contours of a procedural schedule
- 9 done, and you'll just get that done as soon as
- 10 possible.
- 11 Before we go, I want to ask a few questions of the
- 12 parties, but before I do that, I know you have --
- 13 several of you -- that have entered your written
- 14 entries of appearance, those that are present here
- 15 today, but if you would please also enter your oral
- 16 entry of appearance.
- 17 Let's start with Missouri-American Water Company.
- 18 MR. JONES: This is Kenneth Jones
- 19 representing Missouri-American Water Company, address
- 20 is 727 Craig Road, St. Louis, Missouri 63141.
- JUDGE LANE: Thank you, Mr. Jones.
- 22 Platte County Regional Sewer District.
- MR. DORITY: Thank you, Your Honor.
- 24 Appearing this morning for Platte County Regional
- 25 Sewer District, Larry W. Dority and James M. Fischer

- 1 of Fischer and Dority, P.C., our address is 101
- 2 Madison, Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101.
- 3 Also appearing, via telephone conference, is Robert H.
- 4 Shaw, McGinness and Shaw, L.L.C., 303 Marshall Road,
- 5 Platte City, Missouri 64079, and also participating
- 6 this morning with Mr. Shaw, in his office, is Mr.
- 7 Chuck Reineke who is the Executive Director of the
- 8 Platte County Regional Sewer District.
- JUDGE LANE: Thank you very much,
- 10 Mr. Dority, Mr. Shaw and Mr. Reineke, welcome. Thank
- 11 you for appearing today.
- 12 The Staff of the Commission.
- MR. KRUEGER: Keith R. Krueger for the
- 14 Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, my
- 15 address is P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 16 65102.
- 17 JUDGE LANE: Thank you, Mr. Krueger.
- 18 Office of Public Counsel.
- 19 MS. BAKER: Christina Baker, my address is
- 20 P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 60102. I'm
- 21 appearing for the Office of Public Counsel and the
- 22 rate payers.
- JUDGE LANE: Thank you very much. I
- 24 believe I see Mr. Johannson is with us as well to
- 25 assist in these matters in the pre-hearing.

1 As I said before, there's two major things that
```

- 2 can be achieved here today. One is settlement, two is
- 3 to hash-out a procedural schedule. I think you have
- 4 all been involved in enough cases to know the types of
- 5 things that we'd like to have in a procedural
- 6 schedule. The order did not spell those out, but
- 7 should you have any questions about that, I'll be
- 8 available in my office or, you know -- so that
- 9 shouldn't be an issue.
- 10 I guess, at this point, I would normally be
- 11 getting pretty close to going off the record and
- 12 letting you do the business that you are here to do
- 13 today. I do have a couple of questions that I want to
- 14 ask -- while I've got all the parties here -- just for
- 15 my understanding -- I realize I'm just sitting in on
- 16 this -- I would like to understand this case a little
- 17 bit better.
- 18 Is it Missouri-American's argument that, the fact
- 19 that Section 250.010 does not grant exclusive
- 20 jurisdiction or prohibit private water and sewer
- 21 companies from providing service in the area in
- 22 question, is it Missouri-American's position that that
- 23 statute means that the intervener cannot possibly win,
- 24 or was that just an argument for opposing intervention
- 25 in the first place?

1 MR. JONES: Well, Your Honor, I think -- in
```

- 2 the first place, I'm not sure that statute deposition
- 3 has been formally taken by the Sewer District at this
- 4 point. I think that was contained in a letter that
- 5 they initially filed with the Commission. So, I'm not
- 6 positive that is actually the grounds that the
- 7 Commission -- the Sewer District is proposing for,
- 8 number one; had proposed for intervention, and number
- 9 two; now is proposing, or a position to the extension
- 10 of the certificates.
- 11 So that being said, I think that, you know, given
- 12 that, really, lack of guidance about what their
- 13 official position is, from what I do know from that
- 14 one letter that they filed, our understanding and
- 15 position is that that statute, 250.010, neither
- 16 provided grounds for intervention nor for claiming
- 17 that the service area was exclusive for the Sewer
- 18 District.
- 19 JUDGE LANE: All right. Thank you very
- 20 much.
- 21 And I am aware that Staff indicated, although it
- 22 filed a recommendation, stating if it was staged
- 23 solely -- if they were making the recommendation based
- 24 solely on the application and the information that it
- 25 had in its possession, it would file the

- 1 recommendation in favor of granting the application,
- 2 but they're very interested in hearing, I think, what
- 3 the Sewer District's position is, you know, flushing
- 4 that out a little bit, what evidence they might have
- 5 and so forth. So, I tend to agree that it certainly
- 6 would be good to find out. And that's one of the
- 7 things you can talk about in the pre-hearing,
- 8 flush-out what the position is. You don't have to
- 9 disclose all your evidence, that will all happen, but
- 10 it will certainly be helpful, I think, for everyone
- 11 involved to be on the same page, to find out what the
- 12 Sewer District's actual position is, because all we
- 13 have at this point is the letter and the application
- 14 to intervene, which didn't contain a lot of
- 15 information.
- I think that's all the questions I've got. Would
- 17 anyone like to ask me anything, or is there anything
- 18 else I can do before we go off the record and go to
- 19 the off-the-record portion of this procedural
- 20 conference?
- 21 MR. KRUEGER: Not from Staff, Your Honor.
- MS. BAKER: Not from OPC.
- MR. DORITY: Judge, you indicated you would
- 24 be available today -- I guess to the extent that we
- 25 would be looking for hearing date availability -- we

1 could contact you and try to get the most up-to-date

- 2 information available for that?
- JUDGE LANE: Yes, I will be up in my
- 4 office, and I'm sure there will be numerous times for
- 5 breaks and so forth. Just give me a buzz or,
- 6 Mr. Krueger, you can come up and grab me.
- 7 MR. KRUEGER: Or try to interpret that
- 8 calendar?
- 9 JUDGE LANE: You have to have the eye for
- 10 it. I've been here eight months, and I'm still not
- 11 real good at it.
- 12 So, all right. Well, again, thank you very much
- 13 for your participation today, and I'm very pleased to
- 14 see that everyone has brought some support people with
- 15 them, or people that will be knowledgeable in the
- 16 various areas, that could help facilitate these
- 17 discussions. I always like to see it when that
- 18 happens. So, with that taken care of, I want to thank
- 19 you very much for coming today and thank Miss Vislay
- 20 for appearing and transcribing the on-the-record
- 21 portion, and we are off the record.
