PETITION

COMES NOW, GTE Midwest Incorporated ("GTE") and in support of its Petition regarding price cap regulation under RSMo § 392.245 states as follows:

- GTE is a provider of basic local telecommunications services in various exchanges throughout Missouri, including the exchanges of Lewiston and LaBelle.
 GTE provides basic local telecommunications services pursuant to tariffs filed with and approved by the Commission.
- 2. Senate Bill 507(SB 507), which was passed by the General Assembly in the 1996 session, substantially changed the nature of basic local telecommunications service competition and the regulatory regime for incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies. The legislation revised RSMo § 392.450 to permit competition in the provision of basic local telecommunications service. In addition, SB 507 requires a shift in the form of regulation which applies to large incumbent local telecommunications companies to price cap regulation upon the Commission's determination that certain events have occurred.

3. Section 392.245 provides clear and unambiguous direction requiring a large local exchange telecommunications company to be regulated pursuant to price caps when specific events have occurred. In relevant part, § 392.245.2 provides:

A large incumbent local exchange telecommunications company shall be subject to regulation under this section upon a determination by the commission that an alternative local exchange telecommunications company has been certified to provide basic local telecommunications service and is providing such service in any part of the large incumbent company's service area.

4. On May 19, 1998, Mark Twain Communications Corporation (MTCC) was certified to provide basic local telecommunications service within the GTE exchanges in the state of Missouri. On June 16, 1998, the Commission approved an interconnection agreement between GTE and MTCC related to GTE's exchanges in Missouri. On April 29, 1998, MTCC filed tariffs with the Commission for providing local service in GTE's exchanges. These tariffs were approved on July 23, 1998. MTCC is now providing basic local telecommunications services in GTE's Lewiston and LaBelle exchanges. These facts require the Commission to determine that an alternative local exchange telecommunications company has been certified to provide basic local telecommunications service and is providing such service in a part of GTE's service area. Therefore, GTE is now subject to price cap regulation.

WHEREFORE, for all the foregoing reasons, GTE Midwest Incorporated respectfully requests this Commission to expeditiously make the determination required by Section 392.245.2 that an alternative local exchange telecommunications company has been certified to provide basic local telecommunications service and is providing such service in any part of GTE's service area.
