ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

On May 16, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service to Provide Private Pay Telephone Service. Staff requested that the Commission cancel K.C. Telecom Services, L.L.C.'s private pay telephone service certificate of service authority. The Commission granted that certificate in Case No. TA-98-370.

Staff stated that K.C. Telecom should no longer have the certificate because the company's 2005 Annual Report stated that the owner sold the business. Staff included the annual report with its motion.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that parties have 10 days to respond to motions. K.C. Telecom failed to timely respond to Staff's motion.

Section 392.410, RSMo 2000, gives the Commission authority over granting of certificates of service authority to provide telecommunications services. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, and finds that it should cancel K.C. Telecom's private pay telephone service certificate of service authority.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Cancel
 Certificate of Service to Provide Private Pay Telephone Service is granted.
- 2. That the private pay telephone service certificate of service authority granted to K.C. Telecom Services, L.L.C., in Case No. TA-98-370, is canceled.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on June 19, 2005.
 - 4. That this case may be closed on June 20, 2005.
