MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and moves that the Commission cancel the payphone certificate of service authority of Robert L. Harris d/b/a 21st Century Communications. In support of its *Motion*, Staff respectfully states:

- 1. In April 1997 in Case No. TA-97-359, Robert L. Harris d/b/a 21st Century Communications was granted a certificate of service authority by the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to provide private pay telephone services pursuant to the Commission's authority under Section 386.250, RSMo 2000.
- 2. Now, Staff is unable to contact the Provider through a valid mailing address or telephone number. As Mr. Harris failed to pay his Fiscal Year 2006 assessment, Staff sent him notification of his delinquency via certified mail. That mail was returned as unclaimed. (See Appendix B.) Although the Commission has been provided a telephone number to reach Mr. Harris, calls placed to that telephone number are not answered and the line gives no option to leave a message. Mr. Harris failed to submit his Fiscal Year 2006 statement of revenue covering 2004, so the Commission estimated his assessment. The last communication between the Commission and Mr. Harris appears to have been in August 2004, when he paid his Fiscal Year 2005 assessment. The assessment amounts have all been minimal.
- 3. Staff believes that Mr. Harris has violated the terms of his certificate of service authority 1) by his failure to keep the Commission informed of a valid address and telephone

number where he may be reached, and 2) by failing to file a 2004 statement of revenue. Sections 392.210(2), RSMo 2000 states, among other things, "The Commission shall at all times have access to all accounts, records and memoranda kept by telecommunications companies..." Because the Mr. Harris has failed to keep the Commission informed of a current address or telephone number, the Commission is unable to contact him. Therefore, Mr. Harris has denied the Commission the access that is required of the Commission under Section 392.210(2), RSMo 2000. Certainly, Mr. Harris has denied the Commission its abilities to supervise telecommunications operations and services as statutorily mandated under Section 386.250.

- 4. Staff has made an investigation and no other matters are pending in front of the Commission pertaining to this individual.
- 5. The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate to provide payphone services pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo.App. 1989).

6. Although the most recent mailing to Mr. Harris was returned as unclaimed, it is still unclear whether Mr. Harris' address itself is incorrect. Accordingly, this verified pleading is being sent to that same address, but not via certified mail because the most recent correspondence from the Commission was sent to that address, and it was not claimed. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(17)(C)(1) states that "[s]ervice by mail is complete upon mailing."

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Robert L. Harris d/b/a 21st Century Communications to provide private pay telephone service.
