## ORDER CANCELING PRIVATE PAY TELEPHONE CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: April 6, 2009 Effective Date: April 16, 2009

This order cancels the private pay telephone certificate of Tari Christ, d/b/a ANJ Communications ("ANJ").

On March 19, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting ANJ's certificate to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri be canceled.

In Case Number TA-99-140, the Commission granted ANJ a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.

Staff's motion states that on November 26, 2008, ANJ informed the Commission's Budget and Fiscal Department that ANJ went out of business due to declining revenues. On March 11, 2009, Counsel for Staff contacted the company and ANJ requested its certificate be canceled because they are no longer providing service in Missouri. Staff stated ANJ owes no annual assessments to the Commission.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion and because ANJ is no longer providing telecommunications service in Missouri, the Commission finds that the private payphone certificate granted to Tari Christ, d/b/a ANJ Communications shall be canceled.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The private payphone certificate granted to Tari Christ, d/b/a ANJ
   Communications, in Case Number TA-99-140, is canceled.
  - 2. This order shall become effective on April 16, 2009.
  - 3. This case may be closed on April 17, 2009.
